Library Capital Facilities Master Plan Guiding Principles for Establishing Priorities

- Capital Maintenance or existing infrastructure will be given a higher priority than new construction in accordance with Board Of County Commissioners Board Policy 03.02.02.06 – Prioritization of Capital Projects.
- 2. Existing Branches should be considered for refurbishment or replacement as well as expansion.
- 3. Get all Planning Areas up to the current average Square Feet per capita. Planning Areas currently below average have priority.
- 4. Determine how to distribute additional square footage throughout the Planning Areas by utilizing Community Based Planning, School District concurrency, transportation planning concurrency, and citizen input.
- 5. Priority for expansion should focus on Planning Areas with lowest Square Feet per capita.
- 6. Expansion of current facilities is preferable if sites permit growth.
- 7. Give careful consideration to donated and/or County-owned land within the Planning Areas where additional square footage is needed.
- 8. Give careful consideration to partnership opportunities which could garner additional square footage with less capital investment cost. Parks and Recreation centers, Public School partnerships, etc.
- 9. Consider leased space for immediate needs.
- 10. Renew commitment to John F. Germany Library as the headquarters for county-wide library service through analysis of space needs, refurbishment and public safety requirements.
- 11. Green buildings are encouraged.
