## Catching the Light at the Library

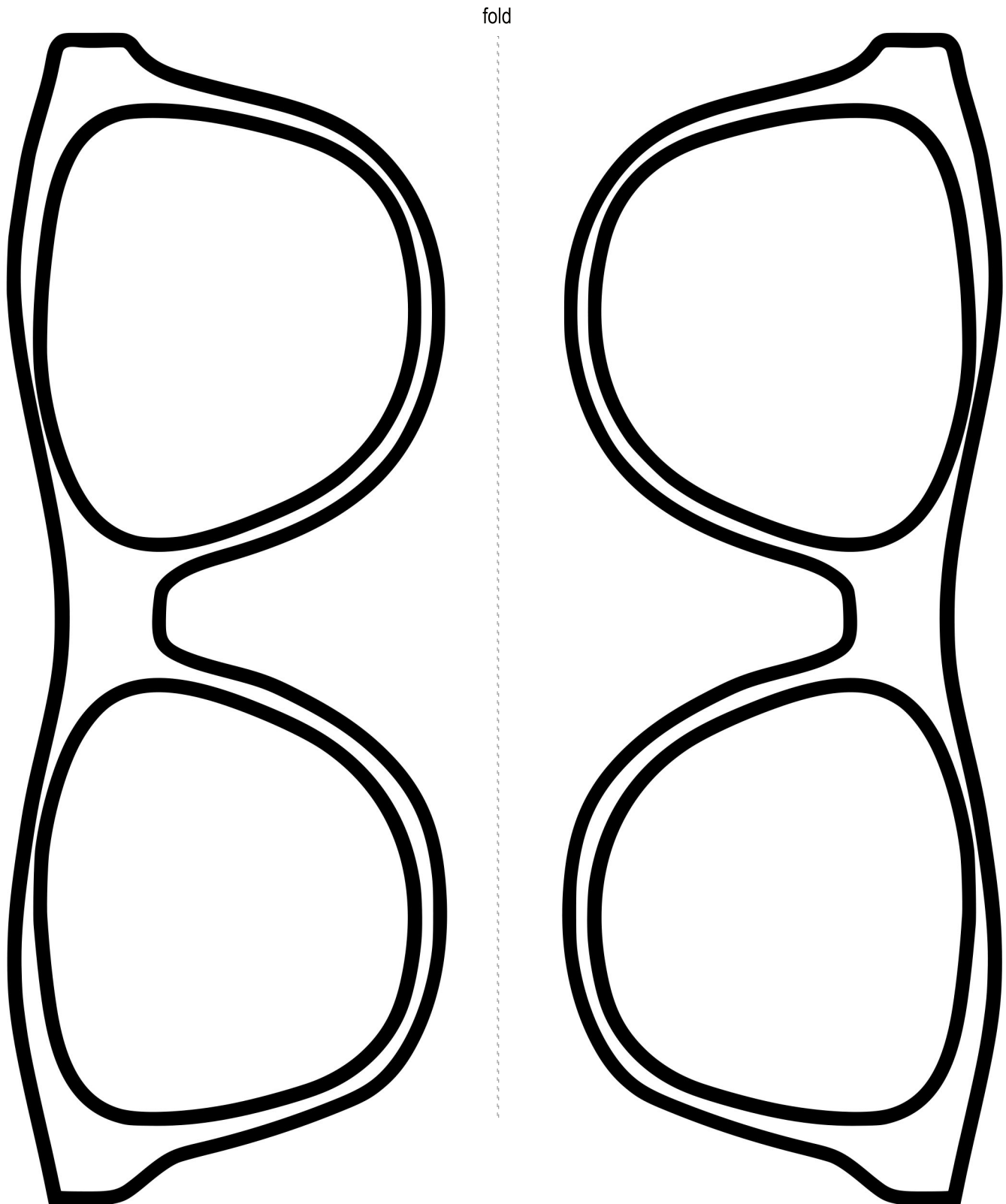

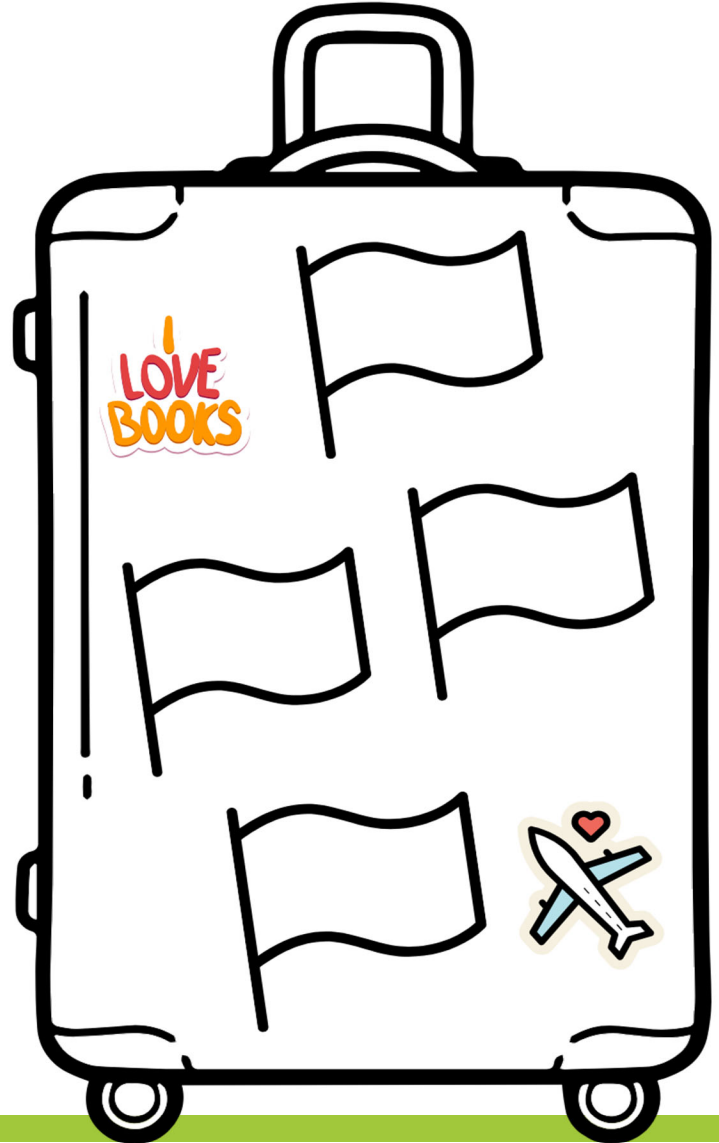




# Where Am I Going?
