Reach for the door

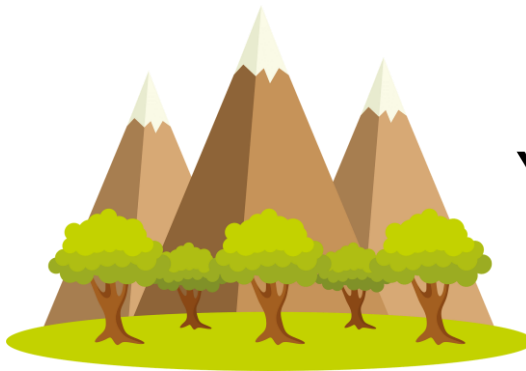
Touch your head

When all the lights are low



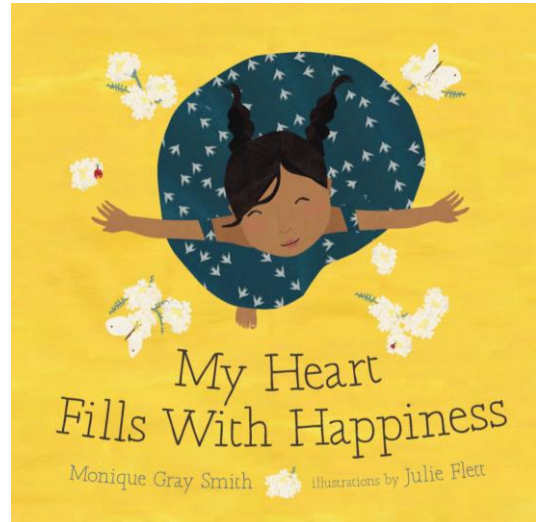
