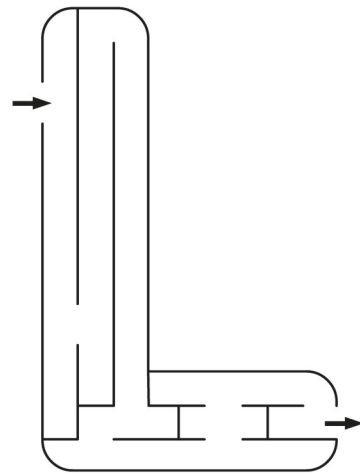

And the little one said, “Goodnight!”

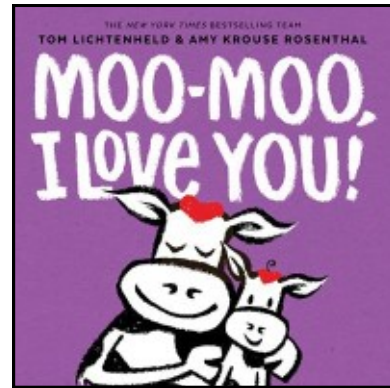
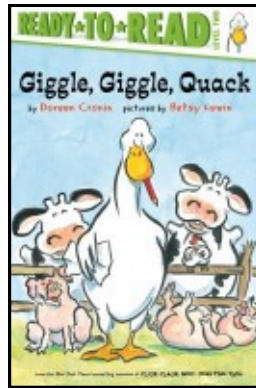
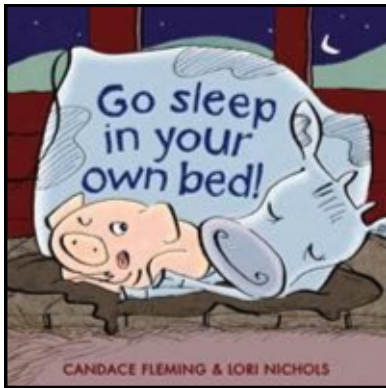
