## Mary Had a Taco Truck




It's not a big surprise!



## Writing

Writing helps children develop phonological awareness, alphabet knowledge, and print awareness, which are all associated with future reading and writing proficiency.

Try these:

Focus on letter formation by practicing shapes. Trace, draw in sand, in the air, etc.

Focus on writing your child's name, allow them to scribble and draw to express their feelings.
