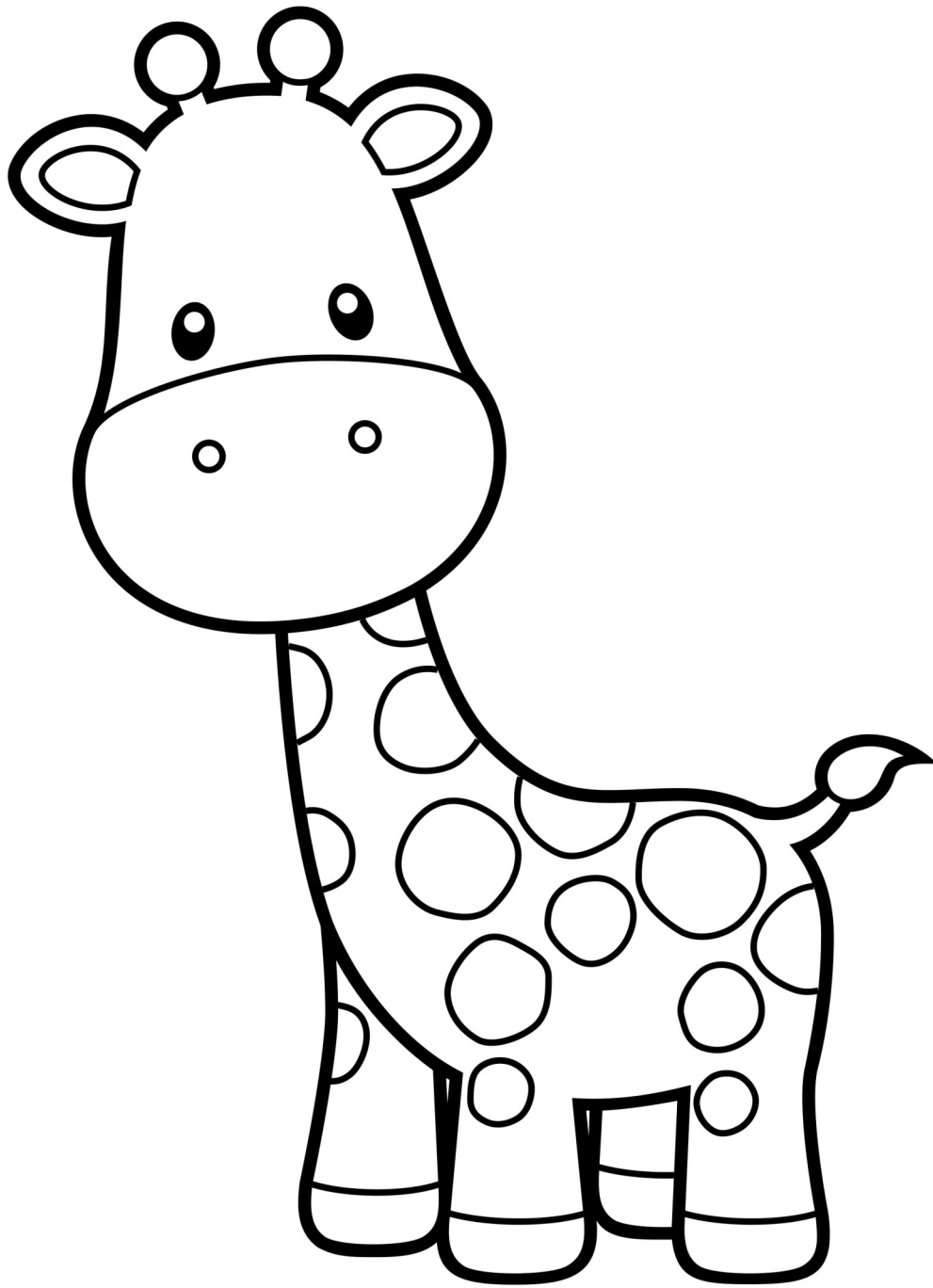


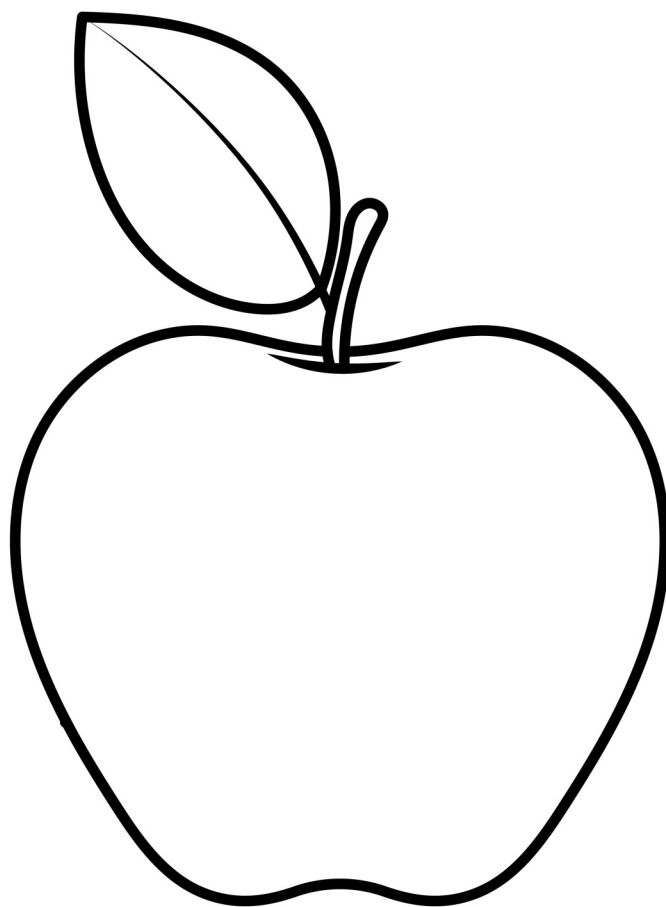


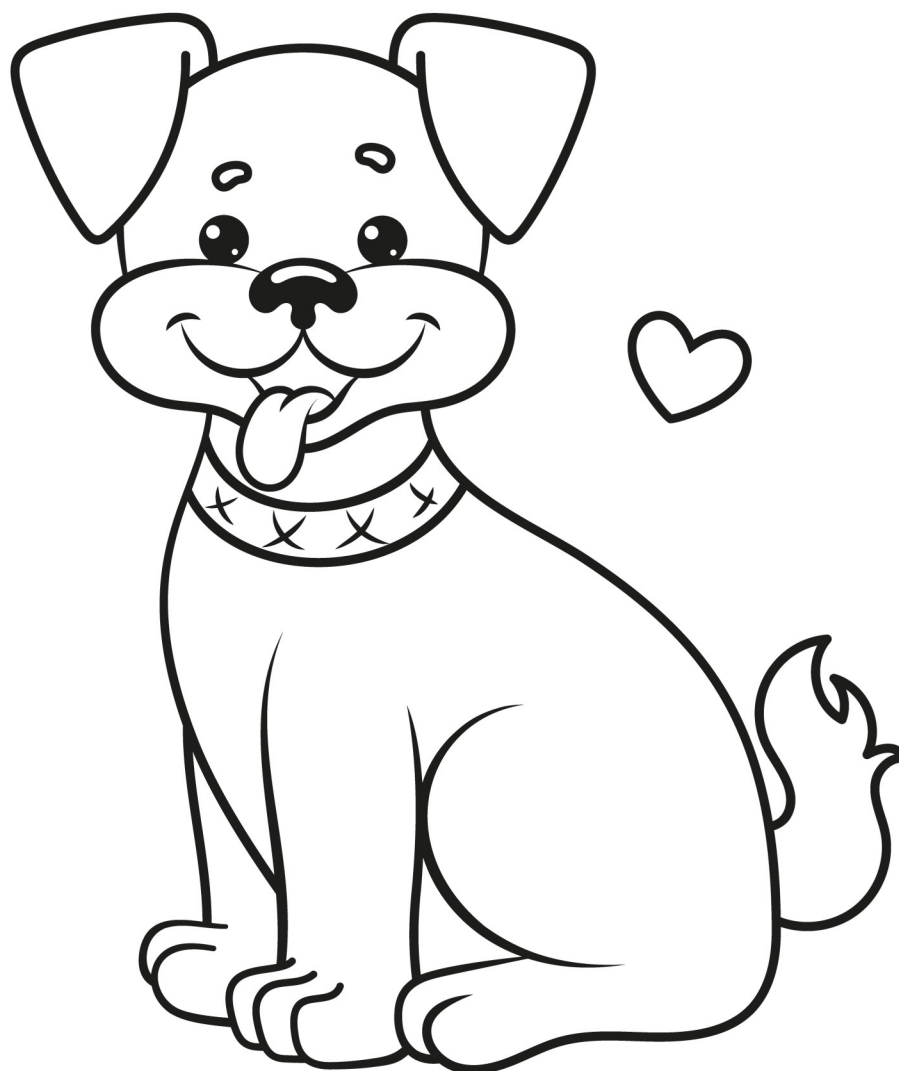

You put your baby up

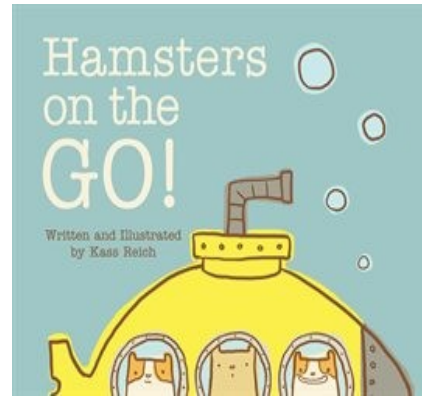
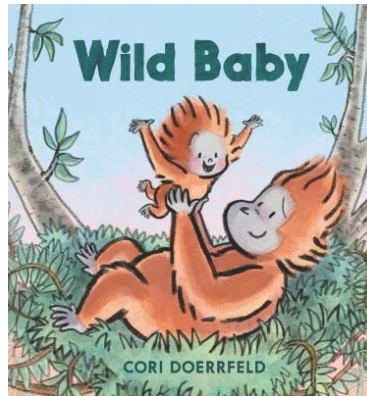




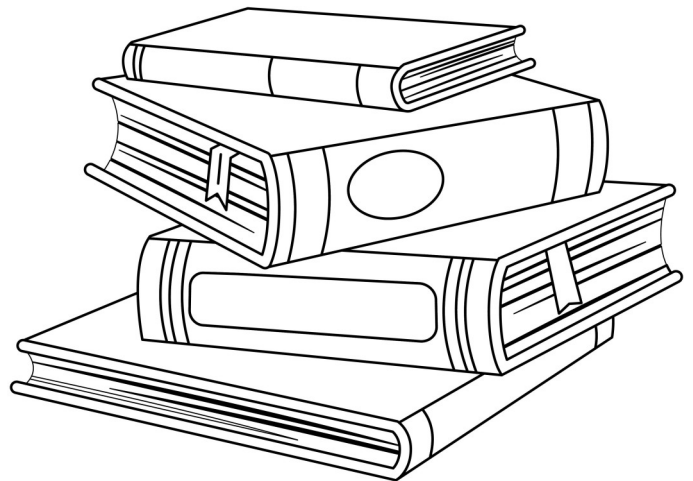
