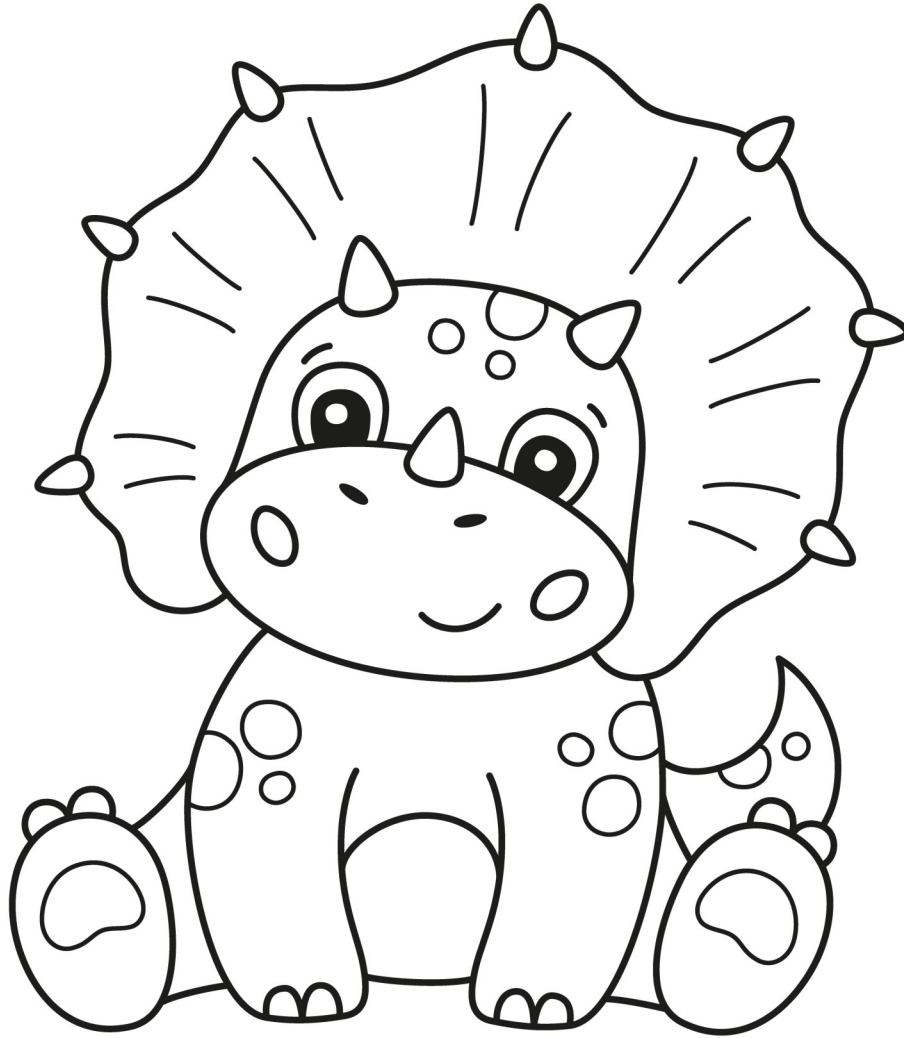


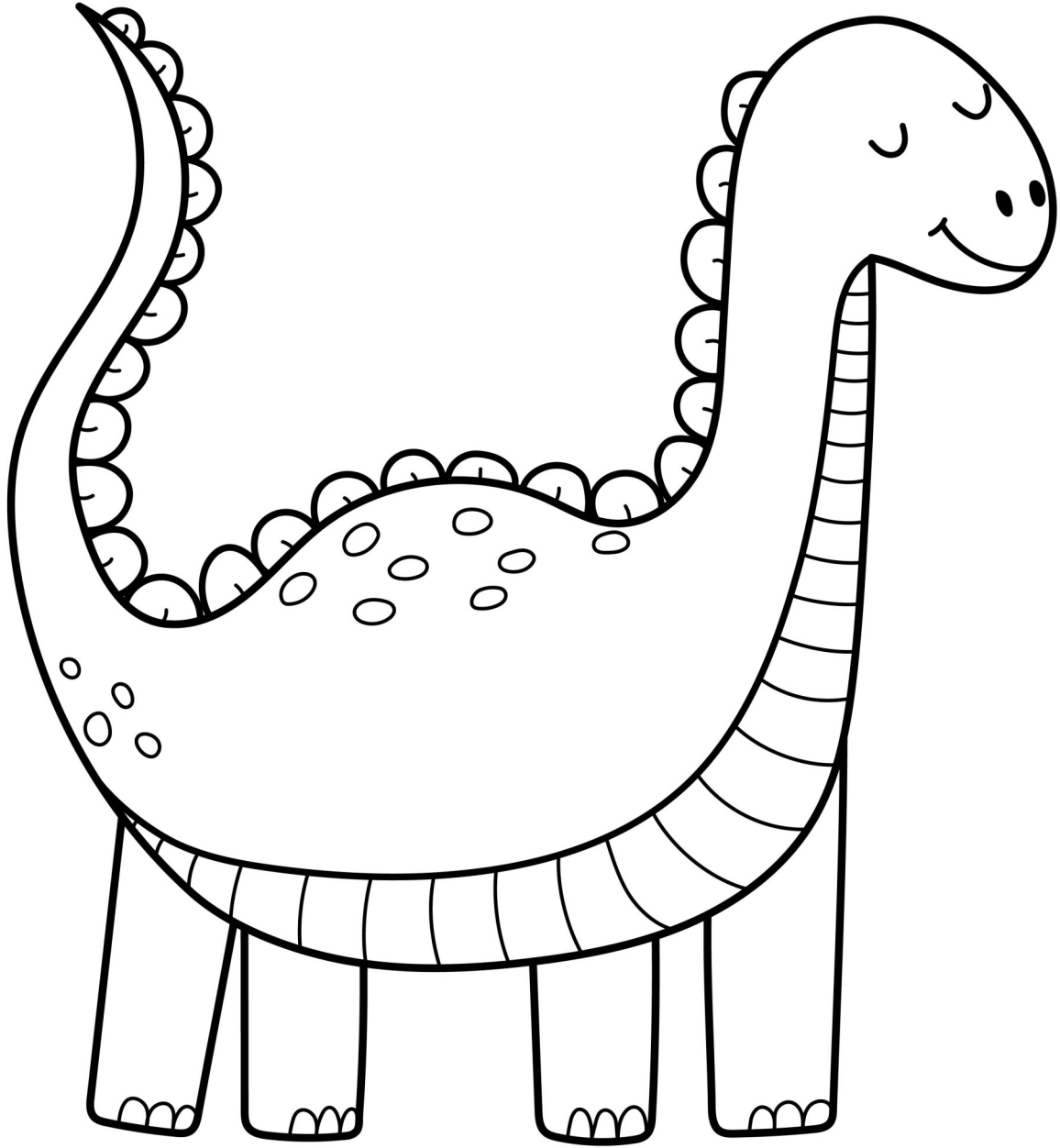

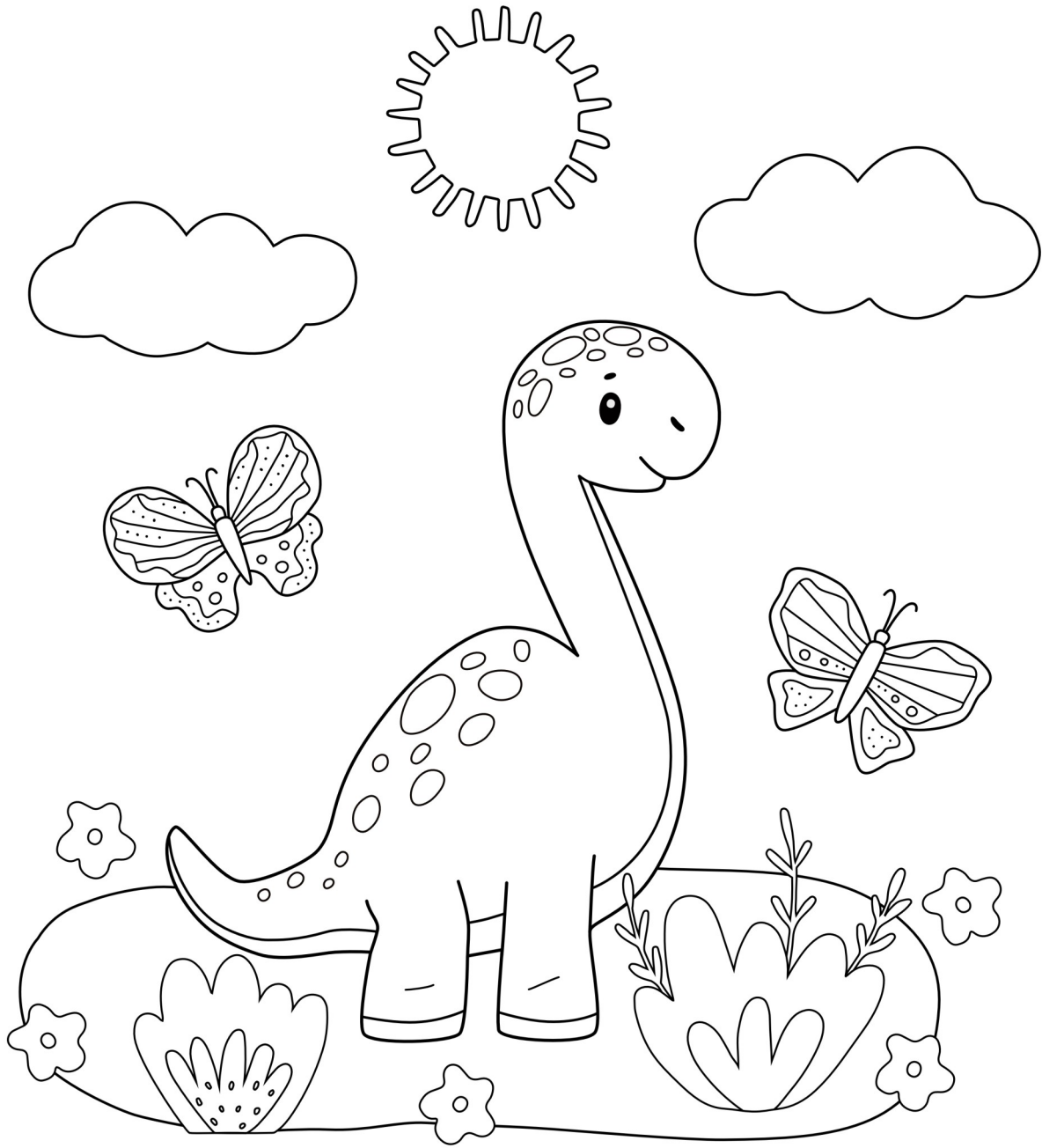

Stomping 'round,

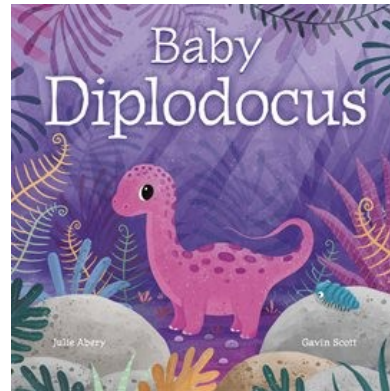

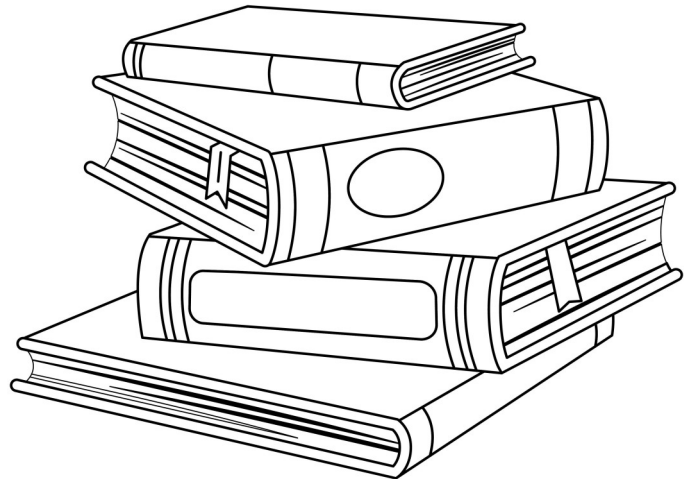
