# Every Child Ready to Read Skill

## Talk

Pointing to the text as you read helps create a connection between the spoken and printed word. Talk about what you see and the different sounds you hear when you go places with your child. When talking with your little, allow them time to process what they hear and formulate a response. Encourage littles to tell you what they know on a variety of topics or to retell stories.
