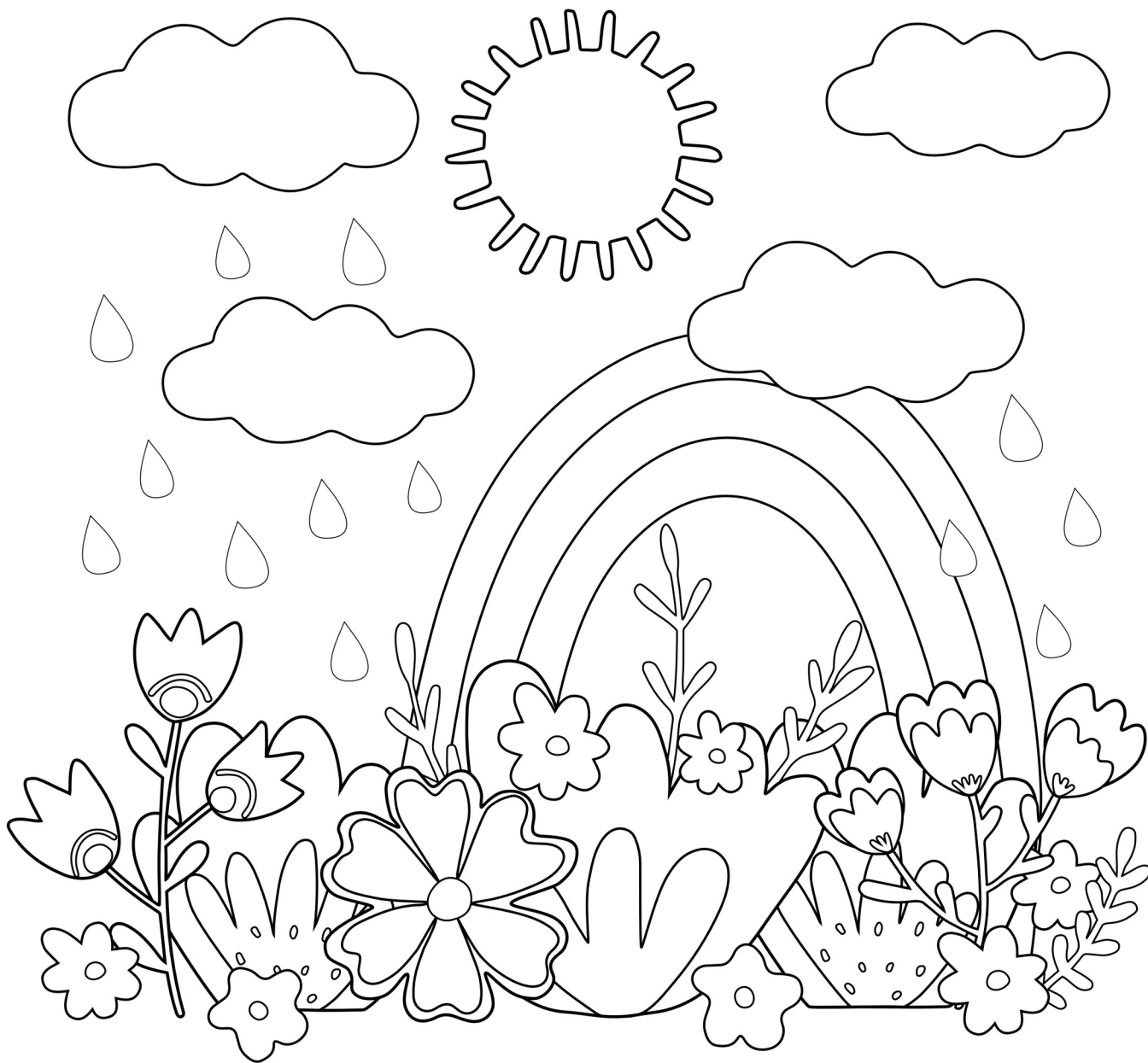

WHOOSH went the wind, and up flew their kite, (Lift baby)

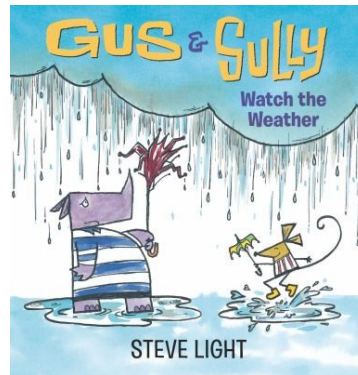
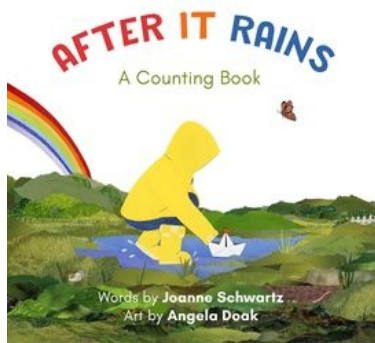

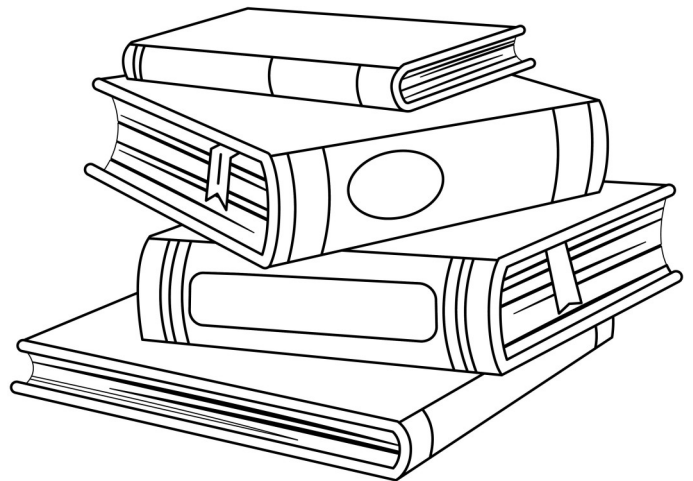
