

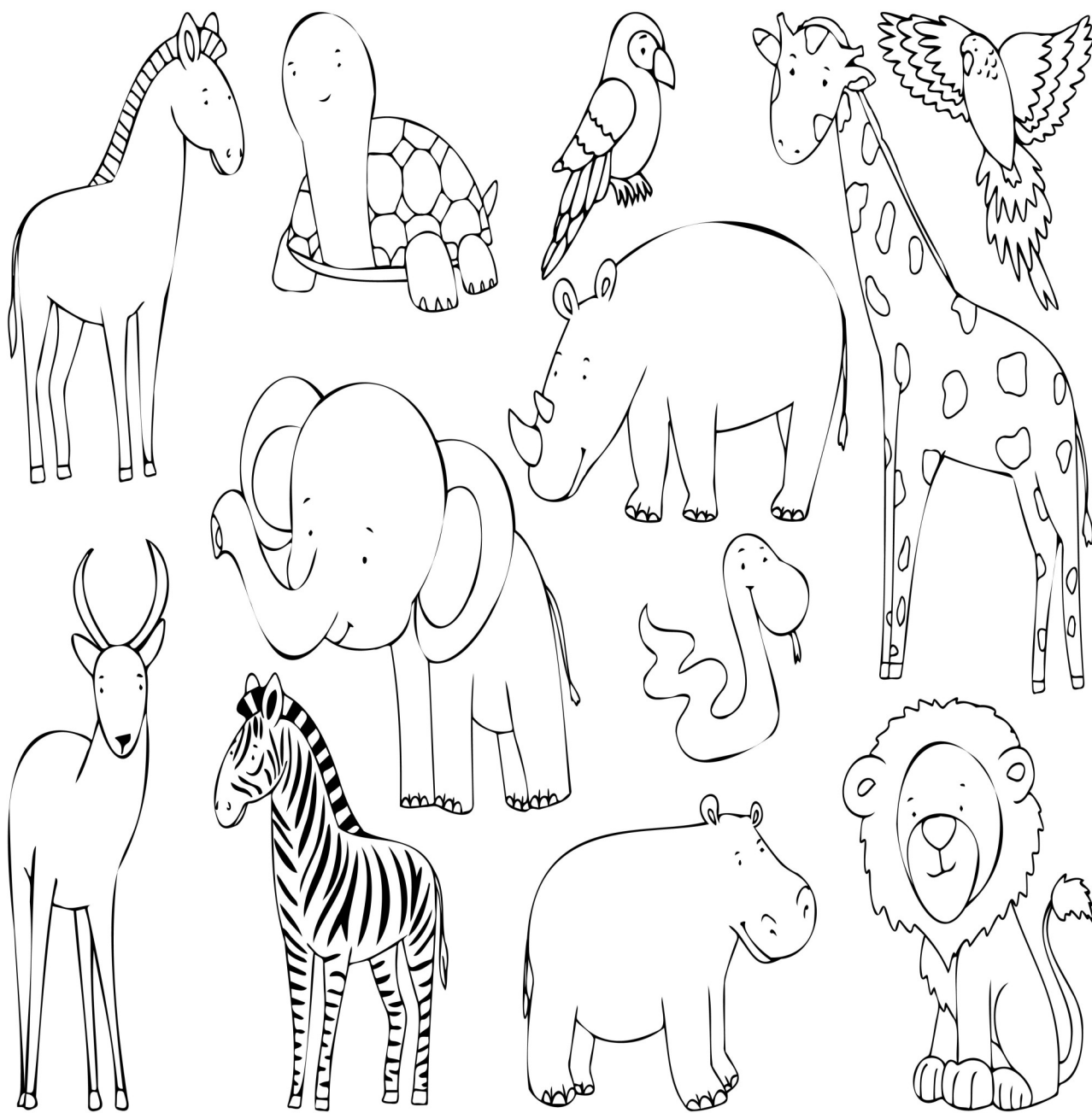


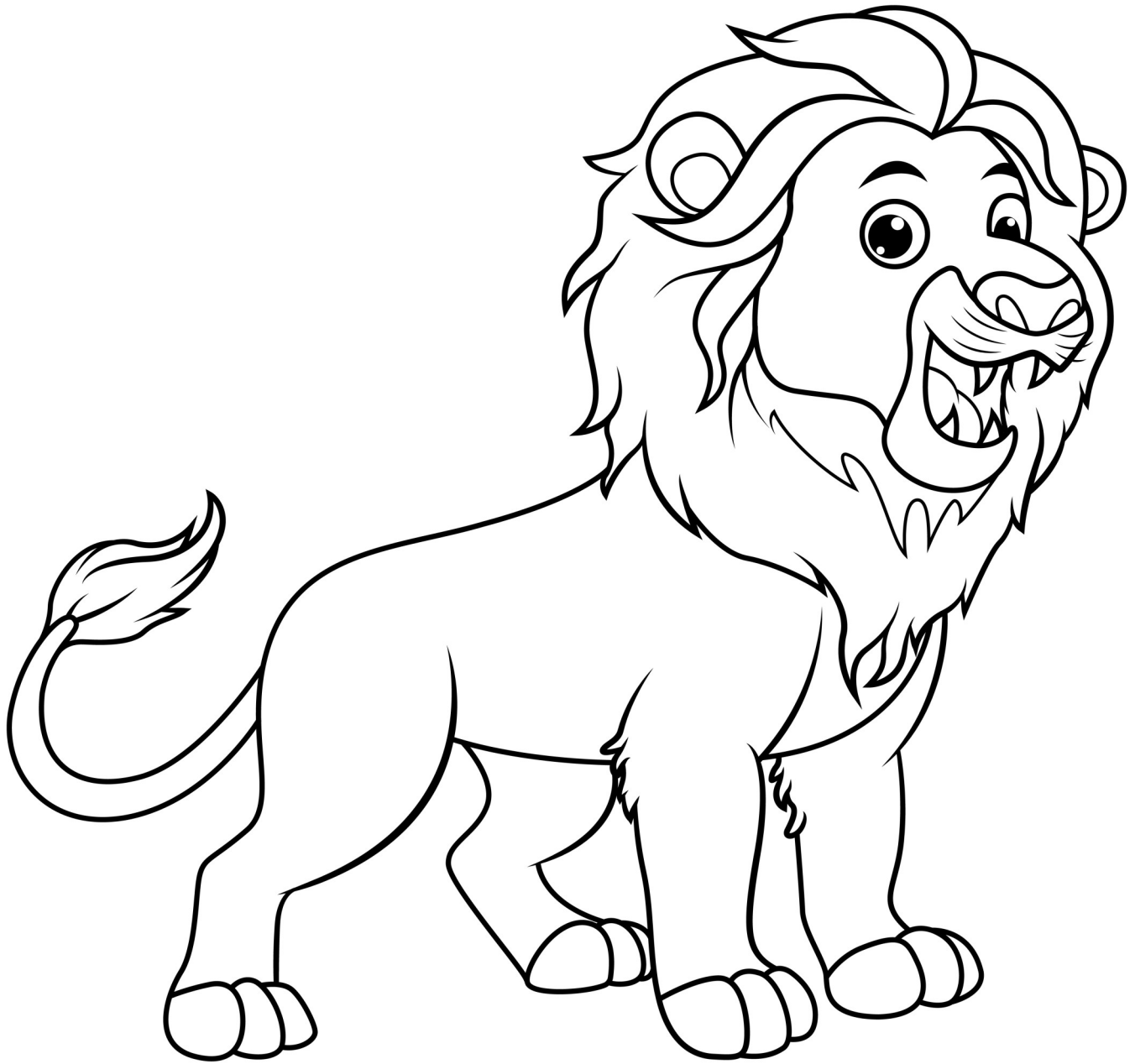

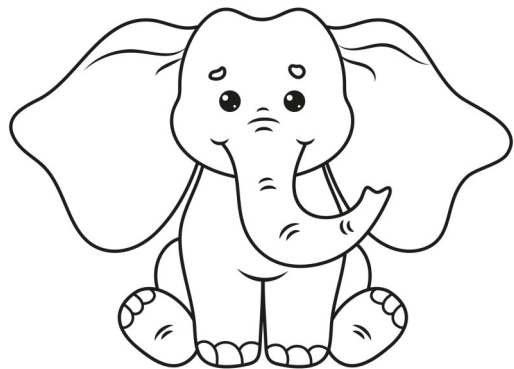
Peek-a-boo, peek-a-boo (*Cover face with hands two times*)

I see your tiny toes. (*Point to toes*)

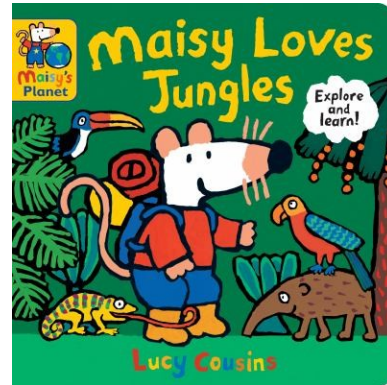
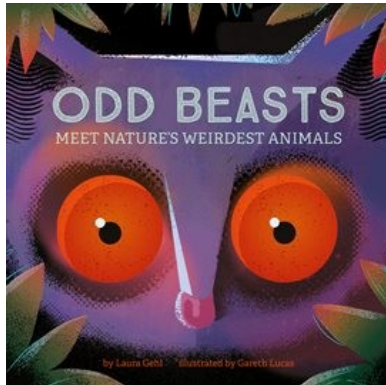

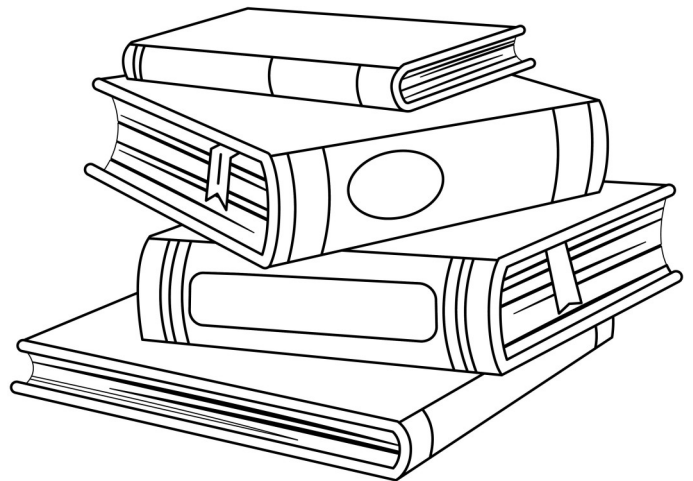
