Hold him high and help him fly (*Lift baby up*)

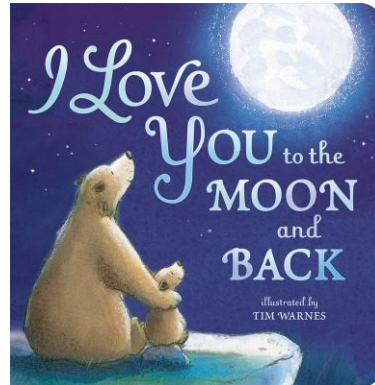
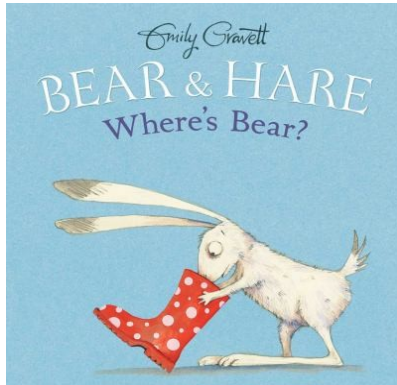
Then hug with all your might (*Give baby hug*)



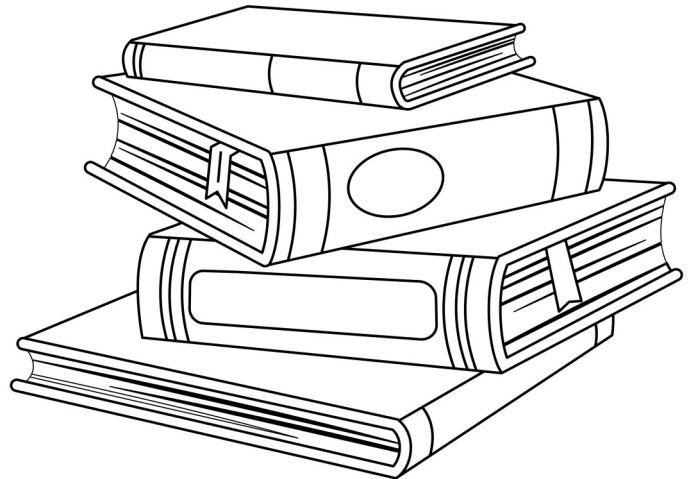
